It is extremely important that we maintain our presence in from of the CA Governmental bodies. (Example: CA law Assembly Bill 44 bans the sale of fur products by 2023. Fur is defined to include any animal skin with hair, fleece or fur fibers, and fur product includes article of clothing but also toys, decor, etc. Deerskin, sheepskin and goatskin are specifically excluded ... but no mention of alpaca. My (Bonnie Potter's) interpretation is that after a few years we will not be able to sell alpaca "dolls" (teddy bears, fur alpacas, etc.)
