West Coast Alpaca Show Update Written report from Laurie Findlay was presented by Karen Ball. This show has its origin in of fall shows—Gold Country Gathering (Calpaca) and AlpacaMania (SoJAA)—that were looking at decreased attendance. One of the shows had been cancelled in 2014. In combining the shows in a joint venture, the event gains strength in numbers of exhibitors and opportunities for championships. A third partner, IAO, has also joined, and we will adopt IAO Cottage Show Rules for the West Coast Alpaca Show. It will be held at the Yreka Fairgrounds on October 17-18, 2015.

In developing the show, each member organization (Calpaca, SoJAA, IAO), contributed 3 members to the show committee, so that each organization has equal representation.
