LB suggested that we outline the process so that everyone knows how it should work. SW suggested that only one person be in charge of the entire process—most likely the Membership Chairman, and then SA can update the directory. Membership Chairman should have access to the PayPal report.

Election Update LB

We need to add to list of bylaws changes that only one candidate per position is required for the election. Sandy will put together all the needed changes for bylaws, in order to put it on the ballot.

Roger Hoefflinger is interested in running for BOD next year.

We do have our 4 candidates for this election cycle.

Calpaca Connection Update-Dianna Jordan attended tonight's meeting.

It's really too late to put together a Herdsire Issue for fall. Also, the <u>Fall Connection</u> is pretty much already in the works, an on-line issue.

Dianna suggested that we do our next hard copy <u>Connection</u> as a Herdsire issue for Spring, 2016, The cut-off date for membership renewal will determine the circulation and the Directory. Hopefully, cost would be covered by advertising.

Dianna suggested that she do an on-line Spring issue, in addition to a Spring hard copy <u>Herdsire Issue with Directory</u>. SW moved that we do an on-line Connection for Spring, Fall, Winter, and Summer, with an additional "hard copy" issue that is the Herdsire Issue and Directory. Seconded and passed unanimously.

We should change the membership deadline to Feb. 15, since the membership meeting will be Feb. 13 (Sat), 2016. Then the Herdsire edition could come out by the end of Feb. We can be almost print-ready prior to Feb. 15, with the problem being that Pam does the page formatting for the Directory in Excel. We will change membership deadline to Feb. 1 for those who want to be listed alphabetically in the Directory—and between Feb.1 and Feb.15, you will be out of alphabet at the end of the <u>Directory</u>. This will facilitate getting it out at the end of Feb.

We should start making a big push to get advertisements. We need another call to plan the marketing for the Herdsire Issue—perhaps the October meeting BOD, with DJ as a participant. BOD members should start pushing for advertisers. DJ will bring this up at the Membership Meeting on Aug. 15.
