

Paca Poo Gold

*An organic soil amendment and fertilizer, dried and shredded
for convenience of application*

Organic gardeners work hard to improve the health of their soil. Alpaca manure is a natural fertilizer that can be taken from the pasture and put directly into your garden without composting.

Why is this?

Alpacas are nature's composters. They do a great job for us.

Alpacas process grass and hay efficiently by means of their 3-compartmented stomach. Undigested high-carbon organic matter, such as straw and hay found in horse and cattle manure, is *not* found in alpaca manure. **Weed seeds are absent.** Decomposition of high-carbon organic matter produces heat that can damage plant roots and make nitrogen unavailable to plants.

Alpaca manure can be applied directly to flower and vegetable gardens and does not "burn" plants it comes in contact with.

N-P-K Ratio (Nitrogen, Phosphorus, Potassium) is 1.5 - 0.2 - 1.1

Paca Poo Gold organic soil enricher provides these benefits:

- a complete fertilizer
- water retention
- slow release of nutrients
- no burn
- improves soil texture
- regular applications help lower soil pH

How to use **Paca Poo Gold**

- Place in bottom of planting hole
- Work into soil with a spading fork before planting
- Side-dress with narrow bands 4-5 inches from vegetable plants
- Put a ring of **Paca Poo** around rose bushes and other flowering shrubs and cover with dirt
- **Make manure tea.** Put one part **Paca Poo** in porous bag (burlap, perforated plastic bag) or large colander; place in bucket with 4 parts water. Let set overnight. Use the strained "tea" as a liquid fertilizer for seedlings and top-down watering
