Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM

- Richard Jonassen requested everyone to review the Code of Ethics on the web site.

- Polly thanked Don Tomkins for his efforts in maintaining the web site and making the automated show registration process work so smoothly.

- Scott Young described several changes to the Extravaganza that were made as a result of the survey conducted last year. There may be another survey this year but if not he urged anyone with suggestions to send them to him. Scott shared that the product booth had taken in approximately \$10K on Saturday.

- Questions from the membership

- Andy Merriwether asked what could be done to get more exposure in the NYC area. Several Board members responded that advertising in this area is extremely expensive but some of our advertising does hit this market. Suggestions invited.

- Paulie Drexler asked members to identify local publications for advertising.

- Steve McCarthy stated that the TV market for Extravaganza promotion had been substantially reduced by political advertising competition. We should be able to cover a larger area next year.

- Steve McCarthy again thanked Polly for her years of service on the Board and as President of the Empire Alpaca Association.

- Paulie Drexler motioned to adjourn. Jack Dibb seconded the motion. Approved by voice vote.
