MAPACA Jubilee Show The meeting began with a discussion on how to raise revenue and decrease costs for the Jubilee while maximizing the show experience for exhibitors and the resulting profit for the MAPACA organization. Subjects discussed were as follow: Maximize Sponsorships by increasing benefits to potential farms. Utilize the AOA public relations person. Look for ways to offset cost of youth portion of the show. Work on tightening costs for showbook magazine .
