VAOBA Education Committee

Minutes from July 3, 2019 Meeting

Members Present: Dave & Teri Grembi & Brenda Landes

1. Follow up VAOBA annual meeting.

a. ACTIONS:

- i. Dave will send a copy of the Essential Oils and Alpacas power point presentation to Brenda, and she will ensure it is posted on the VAOBA website.
- 2. **September Sustainable Alpaca Business seminar**. There was discussion regarding the fees for attending the seminar, with focus on having a third fee tier for guests at a significantly reduced price. There was also a good discussion regarding promotion of the seminar to VAOBA and non-VAOBA alpaca owners.

a. ACTIONS;

- i. Dave will send Brenda copies of the signed agreements from our speakers, and she will follow up to get Mary's signature on each of them.
- ii. It was agreed that the reduced fee for guests (people who do not currently own alpacas, but are interested in purchasing some) is seen as a benefit to VAOBA members who are trying to sell animals. The fee structure recommended by this committee is as follows: VAOBA Alpaca Owners \$125 & \$75 for other members of same farm; Non-VAOBA Alpaca Owners \$150 & \$100 for other members of farm; Guests \$50. Brenda will follow up regarding on-line registration and payment at the VAOBA website to be set up as soon as possible.
- iii. Promotion of this seminar is important because it is a value to members and is needed to cover the costs associated with the seminar. Brenda will follow up with Chanel, who indicated at the annual meeting she would send this seminar information to surrounding state alpaca organizations. Other forms of promotion include e-blasts, AOA website, Openherd and Facebook (encourage VAOBA members to post details on their own sites). Brenda has over 300 farms on her list and will send the e-blasts to them several times prior to the seminar. Dave will follow up with AOA to get it posted on their site. Brenda will make sure the seminar details are posted on the VAOBA website.
- iv. Dave will follow up with Karl Heinrich regarding details of his fiber pick-up offer, then Brenda will include this information in the e-blasts, etc.
- 3. **Education Survey for 2020**. It was noted that the Education Committee intends to send another survey to members this fall requesting their feedback on possible 2020 education events.
- 4. **November Alpaca Show**. There was discussion regarding the 2019 Show. The Education Committee is supportive of Jay's presentation at the annual meeting. That included providing continuous education for the general public in classroom 1, and "Ask the Vet" continuous education for alpaca owners, vendors, and general public in classroom 2.

a. ACTIONS

- Teri will begin producing a looping power-point presentation for Classroom 1.
 She will also contact AOA regarding videos, pamphlets, brochures, etc. with information for general public. She will also develop display posters that will be placed on the floor promoting the education events.
- ii. Brenda will follow up with the BOD and/or Patty Fuller regarding the contract with the VA Tech Vets to ensure they have agreed to be available continuously in Classroom 2.
- iii. Dave, Teri and Brenda will develop a list of "Do's and Don'ts" for general public attending the show; and they will also develop some suggested "key words" that alpaca owners can use with the general public as needed.
- iv. The Education Committee is not aware of resources needed by the Youth coordinators. Brenda will follow up with the BOD.
- v. The BOD will need to address whether the Show Committee can offer other educational presentations. According to the member survey in 2019 there was not a desire for education events during the show. Brenda will address this with the BOD.
- vi. Dave and Teri will follow up with TX-Olan regarding their education model to begin discussions of the education format for the 2020 Show. They will also include this on the fall education survey sent to members.
